1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46 and 49 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
2. The general effect of the Disabled Persons Parking Places Order would be to amend the Harrow (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) Traffic Order 2017 so as to:
 - a. revoke the designation of parking places in certain lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
 - b. revoke the designation of the Disabled Persons Parking Place in Elmgrove Gardens and reinstate the waiting restriction so that waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 8.30a.m. and 6.30p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive, including bank holidays;
 - c. designate parking places in certain lengths of the streets specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for any period without charge;
 - d. provide that the parking places would operate "at any time";
 - e. specify, in respect of the parking places, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge (commonly referred "the Blue Badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 may be left therein;
 - f. provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight, to load or unload, etc.
3. The general effect of the Parking Places Order would be to amend the Harrow (Parking Places) Traffic Order 2020 so as to:
 - a. reduce in length and redefine existing parking places in association with the provision of the Disabled Persons Parking Places in Angel Road, adjacent No. 26;
 - b. increase in length existing resident parking places following the revocation of the no longer required disabled person parking places in St. Kildas Road, adjacent No. 42.
4. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Order would be to introduce At Any Time Waiting Restrictions in the length of Eastcote Lane, South Harrow adjacent Nos. 377 and 379 Eastcote Lane.
5. The general effect of the Free Parking Places Order would be to amend the Harrow (Free Parking Places) Traffic Order 2016 so as to revoke the Free Parking Place adjacent No. 58 Eastcote Road, Pinner.
6. The general effect of the Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools Order would be to amend the Harrow (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) Traffic Order 2017 so as to extend the current prohibition on Waverly Road, between a point 2.00 metres south east of the common boundary of Nos. 206 and 208 Waverley Road and a point 31.56 metres north west of that common boundary between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. or 3.00 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday.
7. A copy of the proposed Orders, of maps of the relevant areas and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at Greenhill Library, Perceval Square, College Road, Harrow, HA1 1GX between 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 11.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. Sunday, excluding Bank Holidays.
