To formalise restrictions on traffic at the junctions of Camrose Avenue and Methuen Road, and Turner Road and Reynolds Drive.

The Harrow (Prescribed Routes) (No. 6) Traffic Order 2023

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow on 13 November 2023 made the above-mentioned Order under Sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to prohibit vehicular traffic entering:
 - (a) Methuen Road at a point north-east of the island site at its junction with Camrose Avenue;
 - (b) Reynolds Drive at a point south-east of the island site at its junction with Turner Road.
3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 27 November 2023, of a map of the relevant areas and of the relevant previous Orders can be inspected until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made at Greenhill Library, Perceval Square, College Road, Harrow, HA1 1GX between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 11.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. Sunday, excluding Bank Holidays.
4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
