

SECTION 14(1)(a) ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC
(TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – COURTENAY AVENUE & CHICHELEY GARDENS

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Management order under the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991. This is to facilitate a crane operation.

1. The order may be cited as The Harrow (Courtenay Avenue & Chicheley Gardens) Temporary Traffic Order 2024, and shall be operational between 08:00hrs and 17:00hrs on 18th March 2024 and shall remain in effect until 21st June 2024 or until the completion of the works, whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that all of the work should be complete by 21st March 2024.
2. Vehicles shall be prohibited from waiting or loading, at any time, when signs are in place, on;
 - (a) Courtenay Avenue, the east side, between a point opposite the northern boundary wall of No. 178 Courtenay Avenue and a point opposite the extended northern kerb-line of Chicheley Gardens;
 - (b) Chicheley Gardens, the north side, between a point opposite the extended eastern kerb-line of Courtenay Avenue and a point opposite the eastern boundary wall of No. 156 Courtenay Avenue.
3. Vehicles shall be prohibited from entering or exiting the service road, between a point opposite the extended northern kerb-line of Chicheley Gardens and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 179 and 181 Courtenay Avenue.
4. Nothing in paragraph 2 or 3 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - (d) any vehicles used in connection with the a crane operation;
 - (e) any vehicles needing to gain access to properties in the closed extents as far as is practicably possible.
5. The provisions of the order will not have effect unless all the signs in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are displayed, removed or covered, or unless at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
