

SECTION 14(1)(a) ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC
(TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – HORNBUCKLE CLOSE

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Management order under the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991. This is to enable access to proposed site for heavy machinery.

1. The order may be cited as The Harrow (Hornbuckle Close) Temporary Traffic Order 2024, and shall be operational between 08:00hrs and 17:00hrs on 25th March 2024 and shall remain in effect until 18th September 2024 or until the completion of the works, whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that all of the work should be completed by 24th May 2024.
2. Vehicles shall be prohibited from waiting or loading, at any time, when signs are in place, on Hornbuckle Close;
 - (a) The east side;
 - i. between a point 5.3 metres south of the extended southern kerb-line of Grange Road and a point 19.5 metres south of that point;
 - ii. between a point 30.5 metres south of the extended southern kerb-line of Grange Road and a point 12.4 metres south-east of that point;
 - (b) The south-west side, between a point 38.3 metres south of the extended southern kerb-line of Grange Road and a point 11.0 metres south-east of that point.
3. Nothing in paragraph 2 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - (d) any vehicles used in connection with the site.
4. The provisions of the order will not have effect unless all the signs in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are displayed, removed or covered, or unless at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
