TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - GEORGE GANGE WAY & THE BRIDGE

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Management order under the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991. This is to facilitate drainage works.

1. The order may be cited as The Harrow (George Gange Way & The Bridge) Temporary Traffic Order 2024, and shall be operational between 20:00hrs and 05:00hrs on 8th April 2024 and shall remain in effect until 10th July 2024 or until the completion of the works, whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that all of the work should be complete by 10th April 2024.

Phase 1	Closure of George Gange Way between The Bridge and Palmerston Road;	8 th April
Phase 2	Banned left turn into Canning Road from George Gange Way;	9 th April
Phase 3	Banned left turn into Canning Road from George Gange Way.	10 th April

- Vehicles shall be prohibited from entering or exiting George Gange Way, between its junctions with The Bridge and Palmerston Road.
- 3. Vehicles shall be prohibited from turning left into the western arm of Canning Road, from George Gange Way.
- 4. The provisions of Item 6 of Schedule 2 to The Harrow (Prescribed Routes) (Wealdstone) (Amendment No.1) Traffic Order 2022 shall temporarily be suspended. Vehicles shall not be restricted from turning right into Railway Approach from The Bridge.
- Nothing in paragraph 2 & 3 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes:
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer:
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - (d) any vehicles used in connection with the drainage works:
 - (e) any vehicles needing to gain access to properties in the closed extents as far as is practicably possible.
 - 6. The provisions of the order will not have effect unless all the signs in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are displayed, removed or covered, or unless at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
