

SECTION 14(1)(a) ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC
(TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – BUTLER AVENUE, BUTLER ROAD, VAUGHAN ROAD & DRURY
ROAD

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Management order under the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991. This is to facilitate tree pollarding.

1. The order may be cited as The Harrow (Butler Avenue, Butler Road, Drury Road and Vaughan Road) Temporary Traffic Order 2024, and shall be operational on 8th April 2024 and shall remain in effect until 23rd June 2024 or until the completion of the works, whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that all the work should be complete by 23rd April 2024.
2. Vehicles shall be prohibited from entering or exiting;

	iii. between its junctions with Bouverie Road and Wilson Gardens;	
(d) Drury Road	i. between its junctions with Vaughan Road and Butler Road;	18/04/24 – 22/04/24
	ii. between its junctions with Butler Road and Whitmore Road.	

3. Nothing in paragraph 2 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - (d) any vehicles used in connection with the tree pollarding;
 - (e) any vehicles needing to gain access to properties in the closed extents as far as is practicably possible.
4. The provisions of the order will not have effect unless all the signs in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are displayed, removed or covered, or unless at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
5. Diversion route;

(a) i. **westbound** via Lacelles Avenue, Treve Avenue, Drury Road, Lance road, Merivale Road, Bowen Road and Butler Road and **eastbound** via Vellacot Road and Vaughan Road;
ii. via Vellacot Road, Vaughan Road and Bowen Road and vice versa;
(b) i. via Bowen Road, Heath Rod and Drury Road and vice versa;
ii. via Drury Road, Vaughan Road and Wilson Gardens and vice versa;
(c) i. via Bessborough Road, Butler Avenue and Bowen Road and vice versa;
ii. via Vellacot Road, Butler Avenue and Bowen Road and vice versa;
iii. via Vellacot Road, Butler Avenue, Butler Road and Wilson Gardens and vice versa;
(d) i. via Vaughan Road, Bowen Road and Butler Road and vice versa;
ii. **northbound** via Whitmore Road, Treve Avenue, Lascelles Avenue, Bessborough Road, Butler Avenue and Butler Road. **southbound** via Butler Road, Butler Avenue, left into Bessborough Road, 3rd exit, Bessborough Road, Lascelles Avenue, Treve Avenue and Whitmore Road.
