Statement of reasons:

It is proposed to introduce a Controlled (Zebra) Crossing along a section of Porlock Avenue, to assist in this and ensure safety on the approach and exit, it is also proposed to install a School Keep Clear along with No Waiting At Any Time restrictions (double yellow lines) on the section between Shaftesbury Circle and Whitmore Road.
