The Harrow (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. 147) Traffic Order 2025

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow on 23rd July 2025 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 45, 46 and 49 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions in locations within Dudley Gardens, Fircroft Gardens, Flecker Close, Gyles Park, Harrow Fields Gardens, Holwell Place, Imperial Close, Kenton Park Crescent, Lamorna Grove, Leabank Close, Leighton Avenue, Malvern Avenue, Masefield Avenue, Mirren Close, Runnelfield, Shaldon Road, South Hill Avenue, Stiven Crescent, Stradbrook Close, Stratton Close and Sudbury Hill
- 3. A copy of the Orders, which will come into operation on 1st August 2025 and of relevant previous Orders can be inspected until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made at Greenhill Library, Perceval Square, College Road, Harrow, HA1 1GX between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 11.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. Sunday, excluding Bank Holidays.
- 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
