- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the Disabled Persons Parking Places Order would be to amend The Harrow (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) Traffic Order 2017 so as to:
- (a) revoke the designation of parking places in certain lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice:
- (b) designate parking places in certain lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for any period without charge;
- (c) provide that the parking places would operate "at any time";
- (d) specify, in respect of the parking places, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant a disabled person's badge (commonly referred "the Blue Badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 may be left therein;
- (e) provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight, to load or unload, etc.
- 3. The general effect of the Parking Places Order would be to amend The Harrow (Parking Places) Traffic Order 2020 so as to:
- (a) increase in length or decrease in length the existing parking places following the revocation or introduction of disabled persons parking places in certain lengths of the streets specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice.
- (b) To amend the pricing in those parking places so as to align with the Councils current pricing structure.
- 4.
