Statement of Reasons

The introduction of a parking place for Council maintenance vehicles at the section of hardstanding opposite the junction with Kenton Lane is necessary to make sure that only permitted vehicles are able to park at this location for access to the roundabout and surrounds.

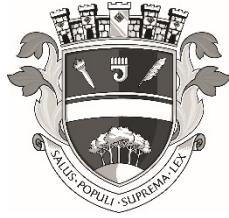
1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to introduce 'at any time' permit parking in Belmont Circle in a new Controlled Parking Zone GM1 for authorised Council vehicles only.
3. A copy of the proposed Order and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at Greenhill Library, Perceval Square, College Road, Harrow, HA1 1GX between 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 11.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. Sunday, excluding Bank Holidays or alternatively online at www.harrow.gov.uk/trafficorders

5. Persons desiring to object to the proposed Orders should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof, to the Head of Traffic, Highways and Asset Management at transportation@harrow.gov.uk quoting reference 25-37 NS. The Council of the London Borough of Harrow, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 and Parts 1 to IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended by the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on *** and may be cited as The Harrow (Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 2025.
2. In this Order, the expression “enactment” means any enactment, whether public, general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Harrow (Parking Places) Traffic Order 2020(c) shall have effect as though to insert items in Table 1 of Part 3 to Schedule 81 to that Order there were the items inserted ** in Table 1 and set out in columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

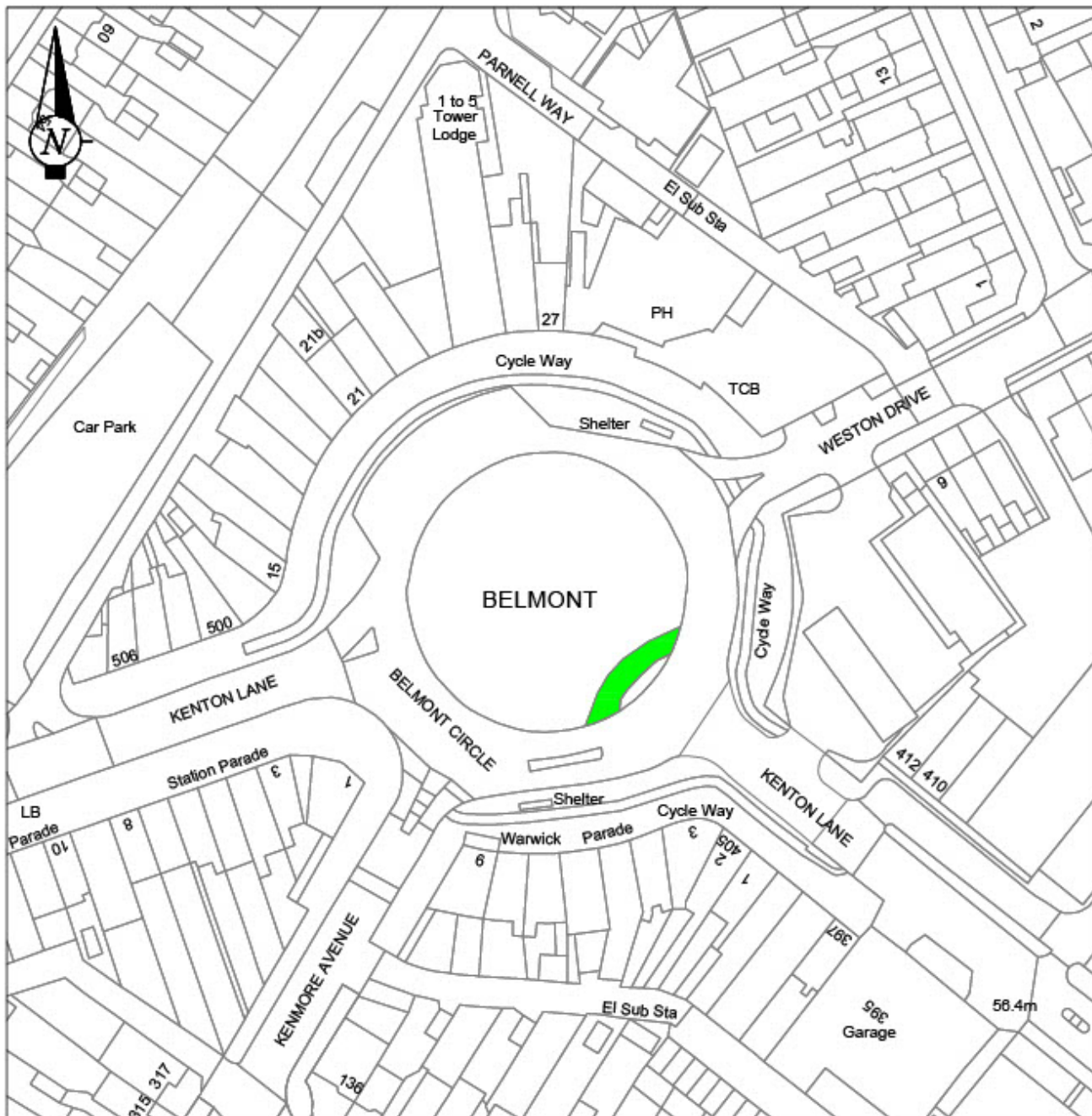
In relation to a parking place in this table the expression “permitted hours” means the period ‘at any time’ Monday to Sunday inclusive of any bank holidays falling on those days. Parking places in which a vehicle may be left during the “permitted hours” with a valid Council workers permit only.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate is general purport)

This Order further amends the Harrow (Parking Places) Traffic Order 2020 so as to create a new parking permit area within the Belmont Circle roundabout for vehicles affiliated with Council workers only within the London Borough of Harrow and introduce new parking controls on those parking places.
