SECTION 14(1)(a) ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING NO. 4

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Management order under the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991. This is to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works.

1. The order may be cited as The Harrow (Carriageway Resurfacing No. 4) Temporary Traffic Order 2025, and shall be operational on 10th November 2025 and shall remain in effect until 10th May 2027 or until the completion of the works, whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that all of the work should be complete by 21st November 2025.
2. Vehicles shall be prohibited from entering or exiting the following roads, when signs are in place;

Village Way – at its junction with Rayners Lane	17/11/2025 – 21/11/2025 19:00 – 05:00
The Close – at its junction with 467 and 454 Rayners Lane	17/11/2025 – 21/11/2025 19:00 – 05:00
Park Drive – at its junction with Village Way East	17/11/2025 – 21/11/2025 19:00 – 05:00
Alexandra Avenue – Warden Avenue to Imperial Drive	10/11/2025 – 15/11/2025 20:00 – 05:00
High Worpole – at its junction with Alexandra Avenue	10/11/2025 – 15/11/2025 20:00 – 05:00
Rayners Lane to be made 2 way for traffic at its junction with Alexandra Avenue	10/11/2025 – 15/11/2025 20:00 – 05:00

3. Nothing in paragraph 2 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - (d) any vehicles used in connection with the carriageway resurfacing works;
 - (e) any vehicles needing to gain access to properties in the closed extents as far as is practicably possible.

4. The provisions of the order will not have effect unless all the signs in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are displayed, removed or covered, or unless at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.

High Worples	Torbay Road, Warden Avenue and vice versa.

Park Drive	Farm Avenue, Imperial Drive and vice versa.
The Close	Rayners Lane, Suffolk Road, The Ridgeway, Imperial Drive and vice versa
Village Way	Rayners Lane, Whittington Way, Lyncroft Avenue, Eastcote Road, Briddle Road, Field End Road, North View, Eastern Avenue and vice versa,
