Statement of reasons:

The Parking Management Schemes Programme for 2025/26 was agreed and approved by Traffic and Road Safety Advisory Panel (TARSAP) in May 2024 to review the Local Safety Parking Schemes Programme (LSPP) across the Borough. This included the introduction of waiting restrictions (yellow lines) to address access problems and road safety issues.

The amendments to double yellow line “at any time” waiting restrictions on certain roads across the Borough is necessary to enhance safety for vulnerable and non-vulnerable road users by improving sightlines and preventing obstructive parking.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
2. The general effect of the Order has been to introduce Waiting & Loading Restrictions as detailed and at times indicated in Schedule 1 below. There will also be introduction of two disabled blue badge parking places in Rectory Close.
3. A copy of the proposed Order and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at Greenhill Library, Perceval Square, College Road, Harrow, HA1 1GX between 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 11.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. Sunday, excluding Bank Holidays or alternatively online at www.harrow.gov.uk/trafficorders.

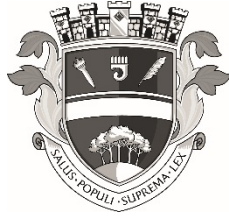

The Council of the London Borough of Harrow, after consulting the Commissioner of Police for the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 124, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on ** and may be cited as The Harrow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. **) Traffic Order 2025.
2. In this Order the expression “enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Harrow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Traffic Order 2014(c) shall have effect as though:

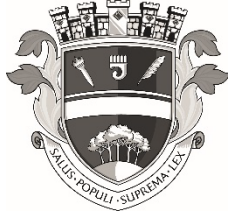
