***The Harrow (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Non-residential) (Amendment No. \*) Traffic Order 20\*\****

**Statement of reasons:**

The Council has received reports that Blue Badge holders are finding it difficult to access disabled parking bays in Harrow Town Centre during early evenings and on Sundays, due to these bays being used by non-Blue Badge holders. To ensure these bays remain available for disabled visitors, the Council is proposing to extend the hours of control for the 14 visitor disabled bays on Greenhill Way and College Road to 8am–8pm, seven days a week.

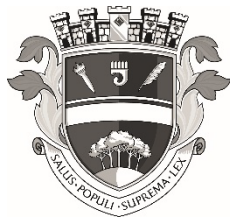
1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to:
  - a) on the north side of **College Road**, to convert the hours of control of a total of six disabled bays outside Nos. 4 to 30 College Road, from 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm and Sunday 10am to 6pm', to 'Monday to Sunday 8am to 8pm'. The extent of the bays and the maximum stay would not be altered; and
  - b) on the north side of **the unnamed service road off Greenhill Way at the rear of Nos. 303 to 313 Station Road and Nos. 2 to 24 St Ann's Road**, to convert the hours of control of eight perpendicular disabled bays opposite the rear of Nos. 16 to 24 St Ann's Road, from 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm, to 'Monday to Sunday 8am to 8pm'. The extent of the bays and the maximum stay would not be altered.
3. A copy of the proposed Order, maps of the relevant areas and the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at Greenhill Library, Perceval Square, College Road, Harrow, HA1 1GZ between 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Monday to Saturday and 11.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. Sunday, excluding Bank Holidays.

The Council of the London Borough of Harrow, after consulting the Commissioner of Police for the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 124, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended by the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on \*\*\* and may be cited as The Harrow (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Non-residential) (Amendment No.\*\*\*) Traffic Order 20\*\*.
2. In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The Harrow (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Non-residential) Traffic Order 2017(c) shall have effect as though for the items numbered 9 and 16 in the Schedule to that Order there were substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in the Schedule to this Order.

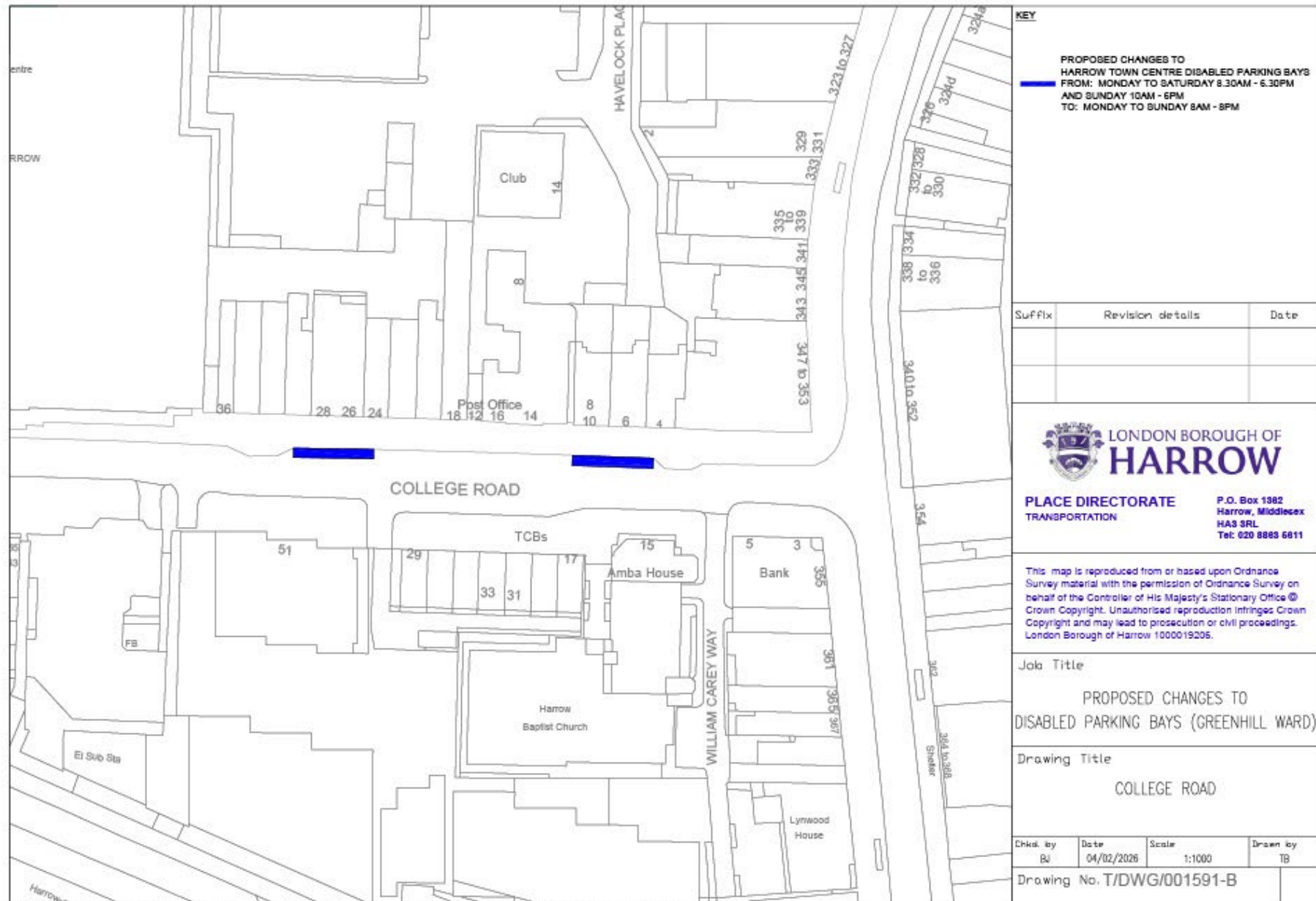

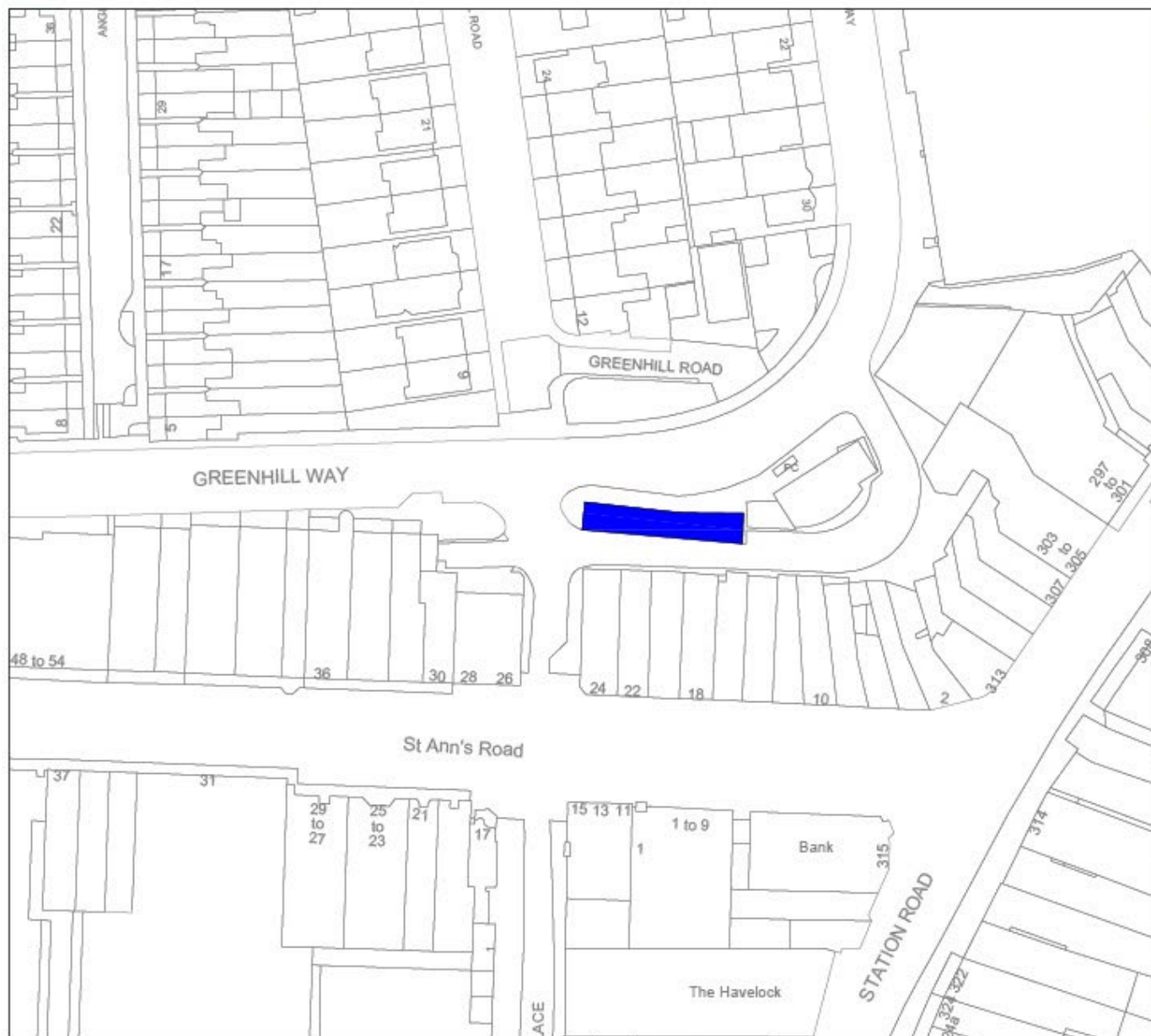
