**The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012
(as amended)**

In accordance with Regulations 17, 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), notice is hereby given that on 24 March 2026 the London Borough of Harrow adopted its new Local Plan, entitled the London Borough of Harrow Local Plan 2021 - 2041.

The London Borough of Harrow Local Plan 2021 – 2041 replaces the Harrow Core Strategy (2012), The Harrow Council Development Management Policies (2013), the Harrow and Wealdstone Area Action Plan (2013) and The Harrow Council Site Allocations (2013), as well as the accompanying Policies Map.

The London Borough of Harrow Local Plan 2021 – 2041 sets out a long-term development strategy for the Borough. It is comprised of a strategic vision, objectives and a borough-wide spatial strategy that directs good growth towards the places that have capacity to accommodate it; as well as a suite of strategic and non-strategic planning policies and site allocations that will guide future development of the borough. It looks ahead from 2021 to 2041 and takes a positive approach towards planning for and accommodating future growth over that period.

The Proposed Submission version of the London Borough of Harrow Local Plan 2021 – 2041 was submitted to the Secretary of State on 26 February 2025 and subject to an independent examination conducted by Christa Masters (MA) Hons FRTPi, a Planning Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State.

The final Inspectors' Report, dated 16 March 2026, confirmed that with the recommended main modifications set out in the Appendix to the report, the London Borough of Harrow Local Plan 2021 - 2041 satisfies the requirements referred to in Section 20(5)(a) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and is sound and in general conformity with the London Plan.

Pursuant to Section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, the adopted Harrow Local Plan 2021 - 2041 incorporates the main modifications (as appended to the Inspectors' Report). It now carries full weight in the consideration of planning applications.

In accordance with Regulations 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), the following documents have been published and made available online on the Council's website (www.harrow.gov.uk/localplan):

- The Adopted London Borough of Harrow Local Plan 2021 – 2041 (incorporating main modifications and additional modifications);

Any person aggrieved by the London Borough of Harrow Local Plan 2021 – 2041 may make an application to the High Court under Section 113(3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- (a) the Local Plan is not within the powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004; or
- (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made before the end of the period of six weeks beginning with the day after the date of the adoption of the Local Plan.
