Vehicle Crossover Marking Application (White H-Bar Line)

Crossover markings are placed in their locations to advise other motorists that a driveway is in use. They are not provided to improve sightlines or to restrict parking on the carriageway. The white line is normally extended 1.5 metres either side of where the flush (flat) section of kerb ends.
